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1 Investment in Research and Development

- Collaborate with partner organizations to lobby the government for increased funding and support for R&D in inherited sight loss.
- Build an attractive regulatory framework to incentivize clinical trials and enable patient access to novel treatments.
- Invest in supply chains and infrastructure needed to deliver cell and gene therapies.





Workforce Investment

- Recruit and retain specialist therapies workforce to meet the anticipated growth for these treatments.
- Prioritise multidisciplinary training and education pathways for advanced therapies.
- Deliver commitments in the NHS Long Term Workforce Plan.

3 Enhanced Data Set and Registry

- Advance medical research through comprehensive patient registries.
- Accelerate drug development by providing data access to pharmaceutical companies.
- Improve patient care through monitoring treatment outcomes and identifying best practices.
- Enable precision medicine through biomarkers and genetic variations data.
- Contribute to economic growth by attracting investments and fostering innovation.
